3	Supply of Hand Driven Chaff Cutter (Toka machine) to landless/ marginal Scheduled Castes families.	<p>The objective of the scheme is to facilitate the landless and marginal below poverty line Scheduled Castes families by providing them a hand driven chaff cutter, so that they can feed their milch animals properly for better utilization of nutrients resulting in better health and production . The land less agricultural labourers and marginal S.C. farmers who keep milch animals and other livestock for their domestic need ,collect the green fodder from the fields but have no facility of their own for the cutting of fodder be fed. Under this scheme each beneficiary will be given a good quality hand driven chaff cutter at a cost of Rs.8000/- so that these people can easily feed their livestock with properly chaf green fodder.During 2017-18 Rs.40.00 lac has been proposed under this scheme to provide chaff cutters to 500 BPL S/c families.</p>	For uplifting the below poverty line Scheduled Castes families.
